- Approval of Minutes
  - Change made to non-CARL member registration price: Was listed as \$38;
     changed to \$42 to reflect suggested 50% increase (from IG Guidelines)
  - Minutes approved with change
- Summer Field Trips Feedback
  - Western Foundation of Vertebrate Zoology: Good tour; information was shared regarding ongoing digitization projects
  - Art Center College of Design: Good turnout; tour was interesting; lunch with librarians was appreciated

# • Fall Program

- **Deadline** to submit is today (September 22). Four responses so far. Would like to see four (or more) additional by the end of the day.

## Reference topics discussion

- Christal created an augmented reality tour of library collections which visitors can interact with; this program will occur during the USC Trojan Family Weekend
- Yvonne and Corrie have used the new ACRL Framework to expand freshman
  information literacy instruction. They designed information literacy modules
  which are embedded within the required freshman RLTH100 Blackboard
  courses. The modules went live this semester, with the anticipation that all
  modules will be incorporated into all RLTH100 courses in the spring
- Kaela shared about her new position at Ventura Community College
- A miniature golf-course in the stacks was shared as a potential activity for library programs
- Michael shared about recent changes involving library departments and job descriptions at UCR. The methods of providing reference will change, with a tiered reference style (students assistants will staff the desks, research appointments and more online instruction will be implemented)
- The ACRL's "Engaging with the ACRL Framework: A Catalyst for Exploring and Expanding Our Teaching Practices" workshop can be brought to a campus or group (Framework Roadshow)
